Petition for the dismissal of Review

Petition under order on the Review petition 11/2015 filed by ABC Service, Section 26 &27 Consumer Protection Act 1986 for the dismissal of frivolous or vexatious complaint and also to detain the petitioners in civil prison for showing disobedience and to breach of State Commission Order dated on 12/April/2015.

Respectfully Showeth

1. The ABC Serice has filed Review petition before this court with a number of frivolous and false allegations against the District Forum and the content of the petition. On 12/ April/ 2015, the respondent appeared before this court and tried to convince the truth with sufficient evidences. On the same day the Hon'ble court decided to review the case again and awarded a sum of Rs.3000/- to the respondent. The petitioner agrees to the court that they will deliver a Demand Draft of Rs.3000/- to the respondent's home address before the next hearing date i.e. 12/May/2015. Till the date 05/June 2015 the petitioners did not fulfil the order passed by this court.

2. The disobedience and deliberate inaction shown by the petitioners here before this court is not new. The same reprehensible behaviour shown before the District Forum and its two notices duly served on time and ultimately to the complainant. I.A No.404/2014

order passed by the District Forum observed it as well and dismissed the revision petitioners plea to set aside Ex-parte order.

3. That the District Forum observed that the petitioners intentionally ignored the notices twice, served in July/2014 and 21 September 2014 respectively. But before this Hon'ble Court, revision petitioners claimed that they received a notice only the 2nd week of October 2014, the certified copies of acknowledgement cards itself is enough to showcase the revision petitioners intention to mislead this court with false allegations and to defame District Forum's observation.

4. All of the actions of Revision Petitioners are indicate that neither they respect the law nor the judiciary, call on a stiff action to reaffirm consumer rights and there to reinstate constitutional legacy of this country.

5. Therefore I may request this Commission to dismiss the review on the grounds of above facts and detain the petitioners in civil prison for the disobedience and non compliance shown by them, along with the award of cost incurred to the respondent.
